Low-wing configuration for broad swath and good downwash for proper penetration of chemicals, and a high, rear-mounted cockpit with long fuselage structure ahead for pilot protection and excellent visibility. And the Pawnees still do the job better ... more cost effectively ... than any other ag plane on the market.

Piper agricultural aircraft have been in continuous production longer than any other ag aircraft, and today more than 5500 Pawnees are in operation worldwide. Today, in more than 80 countries around the world, Pawnees are engaged in precisely controlled seeding, fertilizing, and application of solid and liquid chemicals. Pawnees are involved every step of the way in improving, fertilizing, and seeding crops—controlling insects at their various stages of development, brush and weed control, plant disease control, and application of pre-harvest chemicals.

The Pawnee Braves and the Pawnee D's all offer accurate, reliable dispersal equipment for solids and liquids; strong, tough, corrosion-treated and easily maintained airframes; structures that are easy to clean, inside and out; operating economics that appeal to aircraft owners and permit attractive rates to their customers.

- 3) Thorough coverage without hazard of knocking down crops or compacting soil.

### Pawnee Brave 300.

This newest member of the Pawnee ag fleet is especially designed for the operator who needs the extra performance provided by a rugged, reliable 300 hp engine. The powerplant is the Lycoming 6-cylinder, dual

ignition engine with Bendix fuel injection and constant speed propeller. This proven engine, used for many years in a variety of popular Pipers including the retractable Lance and the load-hauling Cherokee Six, is legendary for reliability and for trouble-free operation far from maintenance bases. In the Brave 300 it provides added performance to the ag operator faced with demanding conditions of terrain and altitude. You have a choice of 30 and 38 cu. ft. hoppers, and of quick-change spray systems in high, medium and low volume, plus an all-purpose spreader for solids.

### Pawnee D 235 and Pawnee D 260.

Piper's trend-setting tractor of the sky is available with a choice of 235 or 260 hp Lycoming engines, each 6-cylinder with dual ignition. The fiberglass hopper has a capacity of 150 gallons of liquids or 1200 pounds of solids; solid and liquid agricultural dispersal units are offered. The nimble Pawnee D's are unsurpassed in their ability to disperse chemicals for fields close-in and with small-to-medium acreage ... with exceptional economy and efficiency.

### Pawnee Brave 285.

For smooth, quiet and efficient operation, the Brave 285 is the standout of the modern Piper ag fleet. The 285 hp Tiara engine, geared 2:1 for maximum propeller efficiency and smoothest engine operation, greatly reduces prop tip noise and makes Brave operation exceptionally quiet. It is available with a 2- or 3-blade constant speed prop. The Brave 285 has the same hopper capacity and dispersal systems as the Brave 300 and, like the "300," features removable side panels which facilitate easy cleaning and lower maintenance costs.
